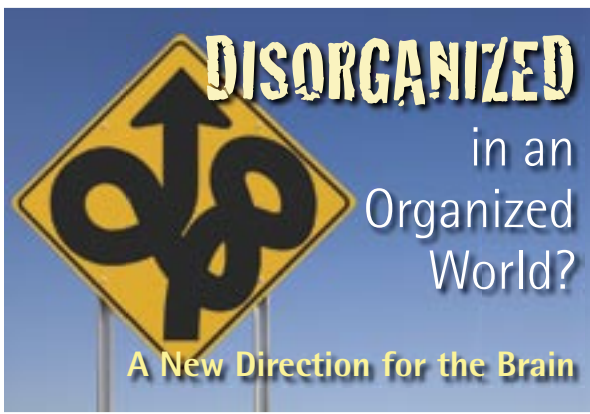
WHY

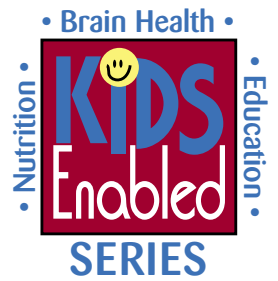
